

# BIRDING AND WALKING MAP

## GREEN ROUTE 'GIMIO HILL'

Monfragüe National Park Extremadura

A. Winter, roosting place. Surrounded by allotments. Small birds as tits, finches, warblers and buntings.

B. Shady place. Typical Mediterranean woodland as Partridge, Sardinian warbler and Azure-winged magpie.

C. Go down to the stream. Kingfisher, Red-rumped swallow and Grey wagtail.

D. Gimio Hill. Black vulture, Imperial Eagle (raptors). White-rumped swift and Alpine swift.

E. River forest (Malvecino stream). Long-tailed tit, Bullfinch, Nightingale, Robin and Golden oriole.

F. Deforested area and bushes. Woodchat shrike and Stone chat.

GPS start: 6° 1' 49.42" W 39° 50' 50.31" N  
 Please don't cycle the route  
 Distance: approximately 8km  
 Duration: 3 hours (gentle)  
 Difficulty: Medium
